- IV. Review Gap Analysis of non-instructional positions (from previous meeting)
 Daniel Zendejas provided an overview of current research into skilled crafts.
 Findings:
 - Trade skills wage comparison to districts—alignment in most cases.
 - Significant misalignment in job titles across districts is a source of difficulty for



jobseekers

• Skilled workers do not necessarily seek out ISDs for employment
