



Gulf Coast Workforce Board Recognizes Terry Hudson for His Outstanding Leadership and Contribution to the Workforce System

At its February 2008 board meeting, the Gulf Coast Workforce Board paid tribute to Houston Work's Terry Hudson for his contributions to the region's workforce system and thanked him for his many years of leadership at Houston Works and in the community.



Terry has led Houston Works since its inception in 1985. On January 1, 2008, he stepped aside as the day-to-day leader for the organization, but continues to work in a part-time capacity with the Houston Works' board and staff.

Charles McBride is serving as the organization's interim executive director while the Houston Works board makes a decision about a permanent leader. Russell Tomlin continues to lead Houston Works' efforts in managing The WorkSource offices.

Last year, the Houston Works eight offices saw 193,859 individual customers and counted just short of 1 million customer visits. Houston Works was the only one of the career office operators that met all 26 of its contracted performance measures and production targets in 2007.
