

Galveston County Profile

Galveston County is located in East Central Texas and is one of 13 counties in the Gulf Coast Region. Galveston County's 2018 population estimate was 327,089. Galveston is the county seat. Other towns include Texas City, Bacliff and Friendswood. The Trade, Service, State and Local Government Sectors fuel county employment. Galveston County is best known for Galveston Island, a popular recreational and summer vacation spot. The average unemployment rate in Galveston County for 2019 was 4.0 percent.

Per Capita Personal Income (2018)

\$51,785 ranking 44th in the State and was 103 percent of the State average, \$50,355. The compound annual growth rate over the past 10 years was 2.6 percent as compared to 2.5 percent for the State and 2.9 percent for the nation.

Total Personal Income (2018)

\$17,497,755,000 ranking 14th in the State and accounted for 1.2 percent of the state total.

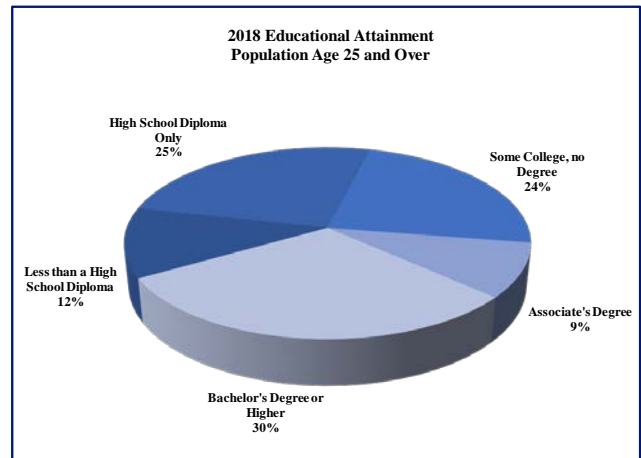
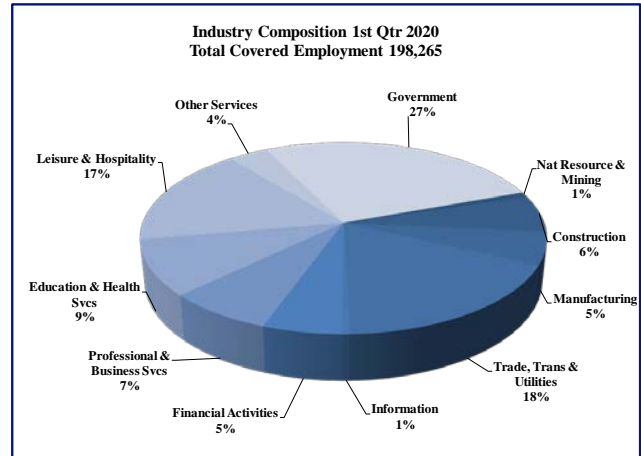
