Help your job seeker sharpen up their interviewing skills!

In addition to **Registered Nurses** and **Physicians**, employers have a constant need to fill the following positions:

- **Nursing Assistants**, who provide basic patient care under direction of nursing staff. This position requires at least a HS Diploma or GED, and pays an average of \$12.07 per hour.
- **Billing, Cost, and Rate Clerks**, who compile data, compute fees and charges and prepare invoices for billing purposes. This position requires at least a HS Diploma or GED, and pays an average of \$16.54 per hour.
- **Lab Techs**, who conduct chemical and physical laboratory tests to assist scientists in the development of new products or processes. This position requires at least an Associate's Degree and pays an average of \$20.82 per hour.

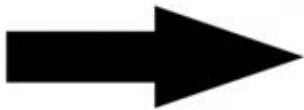
