Current Employment Overview



On June 21, 2024, the Texas Workforce Commission released employment statistics for **May 2024**. Our detailed regional report for researchers and analysts is at http://www.wrksolutions.com/LocalStats. Below are highlights.

MAY Regional Unemployment Rate (not seasonally adjusted)

- Represents 147,447 people looking for a job
- **DOWN** from a peak of 13.5% in April 2020
- **UP** from 3.8% last month
- **DOWN** from 4.2% last year
- **HIGHER** than the statewide rate of 3.8%
- **HIGHER** than the national rate of 3.7%

Monthly Change – Employers in the Houston region added 16,100 jobs over the month consistent with May each year.

- The top-3 drivers of over-the-month Job growth this May were:
 - Leisure and Hospitality: +6,300
 - Trade, Transportation, and Utilities: +3,300
 - Construction: +2.800

Year-over-Year Change – Total Nonfarm employment was up 81,700 jobs or 2.4%

- A year prior, growth stood at 135,000; growth is expected to continue slowing to pre-pandemic levels of 60,000 to 70,000 jobs by year-end.
- Currently, 10 out of 11 sectors show over-the-year growth led by Private Education and Health Services,
 Government, and Other Services.
