OCTOBER Regional Unemployment Rate (not seasonally adjusted)

- Represents 167,278 people looking for a job
- **DOWN** from a peak of 13.5% in April 2020
- **UP** from 4.4% last month
- **UP** from 4.0% last year
- **HIGHER** than the statewide rate of 4.1%
- **HIGHER** than the national rate of 3.9%

Monthly Change – Employers in the Houston region added 12,100 jobs over the month above the historical average of 10,600 jobs each year since 1990, but below the average of 36,000 since 2017.

- The top-3 drivers of over-the-month Job growth this September were:
 - o Government: +6.000
 - Trade, Transportation, and Utilities: +4,900
 - Financial Activities:+1.200

Year-over-Year Change - Total Nonfarm employment was up 60,200 jobs or 1.8%

- A year prior, growth stood at 98,300; growth is expected to continue slowing to pre-pandemic levels of 60,000 to 70,000 jobs by year-end.
- Currently, 9 out of 11 sectors show over-the-year growth led by Construction, Private Education and Health Services, and Government.
