

# Chambers County Profile

**Chambers County** is located in East Central Texas and is one of 13 counties in the Gulf Coast Region. Chambers County's 2018 population estimate was 40,292. Anahuac is the county seat. Other towns include Winnie, Mont Belview, and Stowell. The Manufacturing, Trade, Service, and Local Government Sectors fuel county employment. Chambers County is the home of the Texas Rice Festival, Texas Gatorfest in September. The average unemployment rate in Chambers County for 2019 was 4.5 percent.

## Per Capita Personal Income (2018)

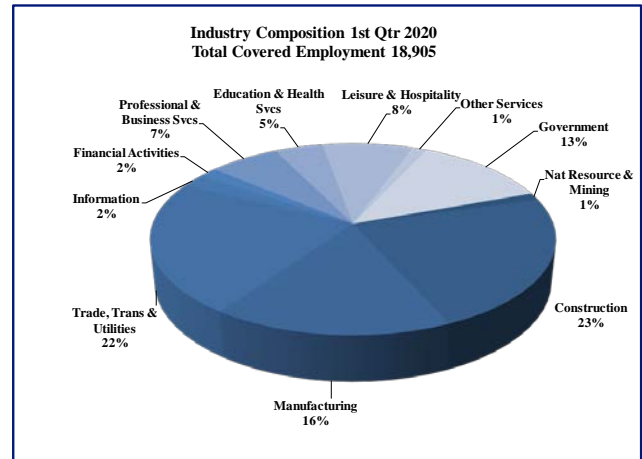

\$2,278,642,000 ranking 58<sup>th</sup> in the State and accounted for 0.2 percent of the state total.

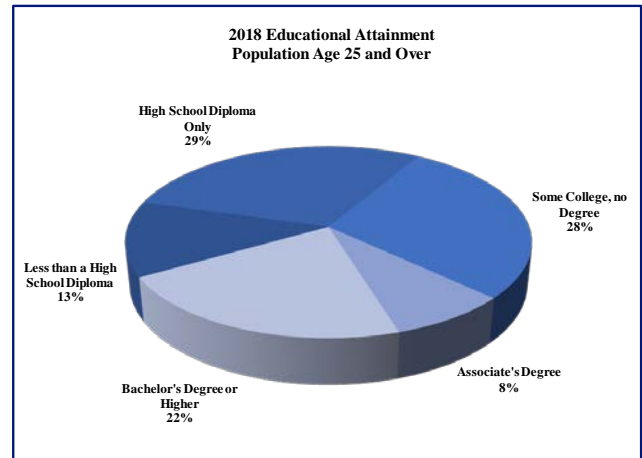
