## **Tecnofil USA Expands in Humble**

Tecnofil USA is making a major investment in Humble, Texas, committing approximately \$22 million to develop a two-building, 155,000 sq. ft. manufacturing facility at Port North 59 Industrial Park. The company has signed a 10-year lease and expects to create around 160 local jobs, boosting employment opportunities in the region and strengthening the local manufacturing sector.



To support the expansion, the Humble City Council approved a \$321,000 economic incentive to fund critical sanitary sewer improvements. The project is projected to generate more than \$11.5 million in economic return to the region, according to city officials.

Workforce Solutions, in collaboration with the Lake Houston Chamber, is serving as the primary staffing partner, assisting Tecnofil in identifying and hiring qualified candidates for its upcoming workforce needs. Hiring is expected to begin in late summer 2025, with a variety of roles in production, operations, and support functions. This initiative aligns with the Gulf Coast Workforce Board's goal of connecting residents to high-quality, local employment opportunities that lead to long-term career growth.

# Apprenticeship Helps Fill Talent Needs at Letsos Company

A recent Fox 26 story highlights how local apprenticeship programs are connecting motivated workers with high-demand skilled trades careers. After completing a free, three-week readiness course, Ivan Hernandez joined a paid pipefitter apprenticeship with Letsos Company. The Houston Gulf Coast Building and Construction Trades Council offers 13 apprenticeship tracks—including electrical, plumbing, and iron work—with starting wages of \$15–\$25/hour and benefits. Employers gain trained, committed workers ready to meet industry demand—especially as infrastructure projects drive the need for hundreds of skilled tradespeople.

## **Apprenticeship Readiness Program**

The Houston Gulf Coast Building and Construction Trades Council is now accepting applications for Cohort 17 of its Apprenticeship Readiness Program (ARP). This free training, featuring the nationally recognized Multi-Craft Core Curriculum (MC3), prepares participants for U.S. Department of Labor (DOL)-registered apprenticeships in 13 high-demand trades, including electrical, plumbing, pipefitting, and HVAC and Refrigeration. Participants will complete both classroom and hands-on training, gaining essential skills needed for success in a registered apprenticeship.

Interviews start August 25 | Classes begin October 13 Classes run Monday - Friday from 7 a.m. - 3:30 p.m. for three weeks

## Monthly Jobs Report

We are your best source for the latest developments in Houston's regional labor market. May 2025 highlights include Houston adding 3,600 jobs in May, versus 13,000 jobs historically. The unemployment rate ticked up to 4.2% compared to 4.0% both statewide and nationally but remains low despite the weak job growth.



# **Quarterly Reports** by County

We publish quarterly countylevel employment data, including jobs, wages, and unemployment. These reports support job seekers, counselors, economic developers, agencies, and others needing detailed insights into local workforce and salary trends.



#### Rising Wages

According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics' Employment Cost Index, the Houston region saw a 7.5% increase in total compensation for private industry workers between first quarter 2024 and first quarter 2025, the highest percentage increase among the 15 largest metropolitan areas for which data is published.
