What Makes the Program Unique

- Addresses the financial barrier for districts
- Built-in quality and completion support
- Separate from HB2 and prior grants
- No income qualification for apprentices

Financial Incentives

Who's Eligible

- Public, private and charter districts
- Active Registered Teacher Apprenticeships
- Apprentices must be enrolled in a program and working towards certification

How it Works

- \$2,000 per apprentice per year
- Districts will receive an estimate dollar amount based on apprentice count
- Final payment amount in mid- to late-September

Purpose:

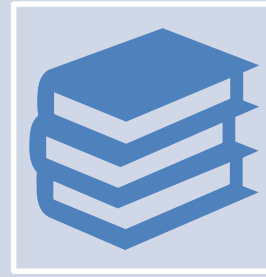

Framework Overview: Apprentice -Centered Support Model



Comprehensive Apprentice Support

The framework provides structured support from program entry to classroom readiness and workforce placement.



Individualized Counseling

Regular one-on-one counseling offers personalized guidance to address academic, professional, and personal development.



Persistence and Attrition Reduction

Early identification of challenges with timely interventions promotes persistence and reduces dropout rates.



Collaborative Accountability

The framework fosters accountability among districts, mentors, and training providers to elevate apprentice success.

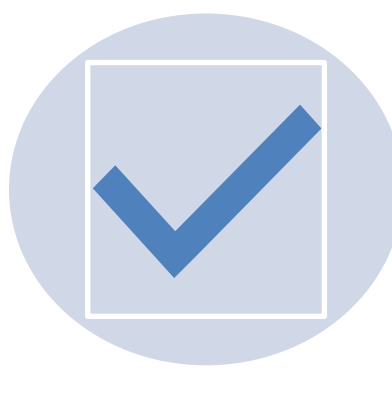

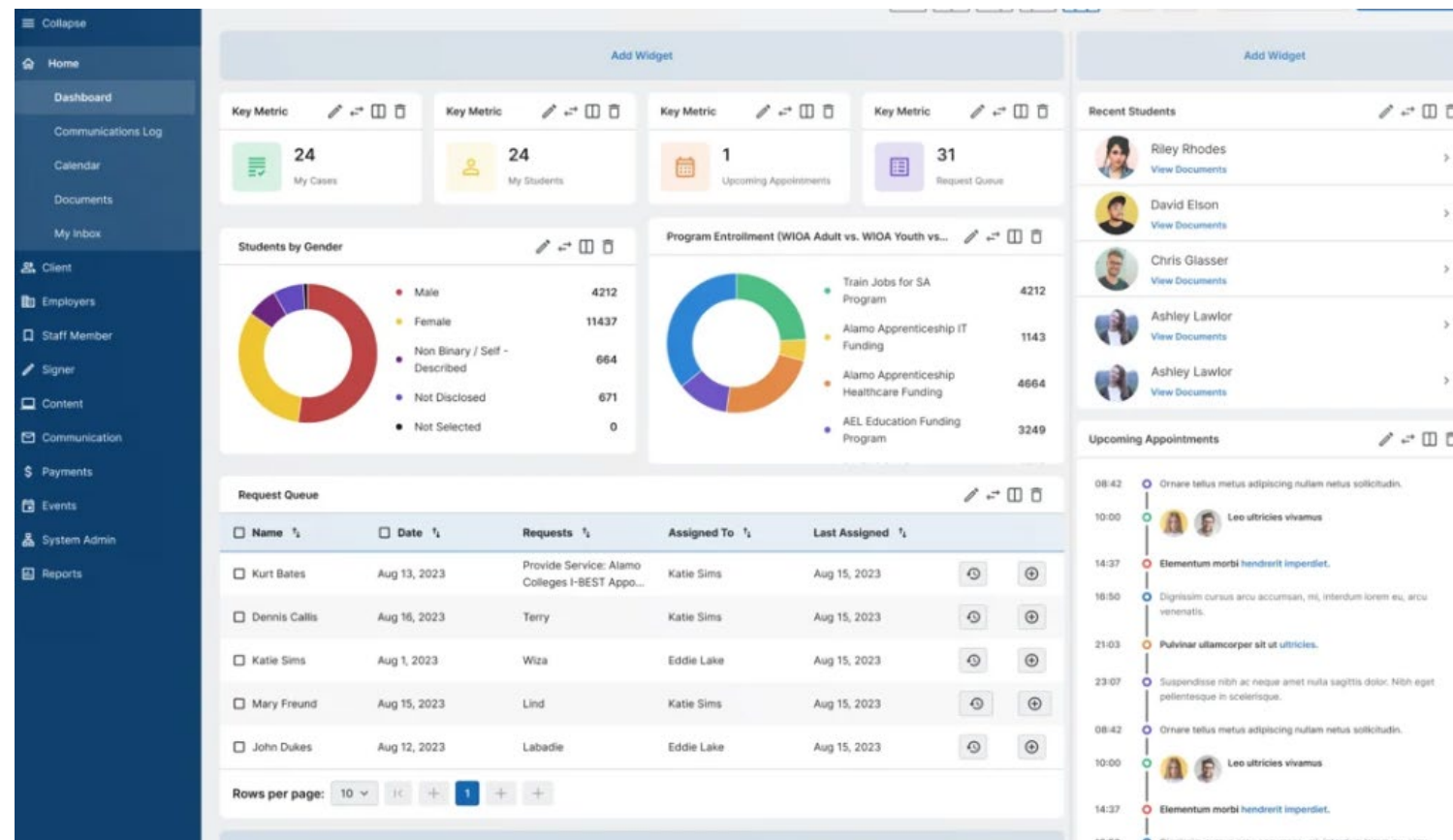

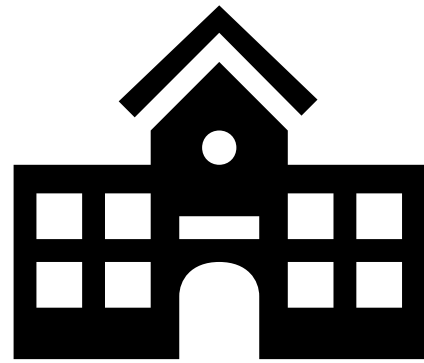

How to Apply

1. Complete the MS Forms application (included here and will be emailed out)
2. Submit first apprentice roster to GCWBcareerpathways@wrksolutions.net
 - Apprentice names
 - Teaching assignments
 - Campus assignments
 - Number of college hours completed OR on-ramp/apprentice level placement (i.e. Level 1, On-ramp 2, etc)
3. Wait for workforce board staff to review
4. Provide financial information to process payment
5. Receive notification of funding
6. Submit final roster of apprentices
